CORONAVIRUS PRECAUTIONS

DHBC assumes and expects all members and guests to take personal responsibility for personal hygiene.

- * Cleaning and sanitizing of our building and facilities is done the day before each service by a professional cleaning service.
- * We ask that if you feel ill or under the weather that you go home and enjoy our service that is available on our website.

- * Our security team is screening all that enter the building for signs of fever, cough or just peakedness. (laser temp available)
- * Our security team wears gloves when touching others or assisting in an emergency situation, should it arise.
- * We open all doors and ask you to not handle any door knobs or pull handles.
- * We recommend you sit at least 6' between each family group during service.
(taking into account same household members)
- * We practice and encourage Social Distancing while in the building or moving about.
- * We have multiple exits for your departure following service so to accommodate social distancing practices.
- * There is no greeting, touching, or shaking hands during our services.
(air waves are encouraged)
- * We have placed fans that are equipped to ionize for germs, in each education area and meeting area to be run non stop during and after meetings or service.
- * There are placed hands free sanitizers in our main halls and worship center for your use.
- * We encourage all that have elevated risk factors to weight their risk versus coming to service.
