The Heart

There King David sat. Magnanimously looking over all his kingdom. Lavishly living in a palace with servants and comforts beyond this shepherd boy's imagination. And it suddenly occurred to him, "Lo, I dwell in the house of cedars, but the ark of the covenant of the Lord remaineth under curtains." Ah, poor little ol' God...

The prophet Nathan tells the king to "Do all that is in thy HEART; for God is with thee." (1 Chronicles 17:1-2)

One of the only times Nathan misspoke. Yes God's HEART was with David. But David's HEART was not in complete alignment with God's.

1 Chronicles 17:3 begins describing God's HEART on the matter of His dwelling place. Beginning with telling Nathan to tell David he "shall NOT build Me an house to dwell in." Reminding the prophet and the king that He has never dwelt in a home made by hands. Only presented Himself to the nation in the Tabernacle for their sakes. God continues by describing a temple His Man shall build. He describes His Man as an heir of David's that will sit on David's throne. Saying in vs 12, "He shall build me an house and I will establish His throne forever." Hmmmm. I wonder Who that could be?

By vs. 19, David is yet again humbled and in AWE of God. Saying, "Oh LORD, for thzaqqwq212y servants' sake, and according to Thine own HEART, hast Thou done all this greatness."

David loved God. Nathan was God's prophet. Yet neither man knew God's HEART on the matter of His dwelling. Neither knew of the Temple of the CHURCH not made with hands (Acts 7:48; 17:24) and the Only begotten Son Jesus, Who would sit on the throne forever.

My friends, we sit in AWE of what God has done for us. Yet "Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the HEART of man the things which God has prepared for those who love Him." (1 Corinthians 2:9)

Let us seek His HEART all the more! Let us LOVE Him with all our HEART!!!
